Introduction:

- 1. THE TEST: Mark 12:13-15b
 - PHARISEES: Then they sent to Him some of the Pharisees and the Herodians, to catch Him in His words. (Mark 12:13)
 - JESUS: Catch Me if you can! (Mark 12:13)
 - PHARISEES: Teacher, we know that You are true. (Mark 12:14a)
 - PHARISEES: Is it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar or not? (Mark 12:14b,15a)
 - JESUS: Why do you Test Me? (Mark 12:15b)
- 2. THE TESTIMONY: Mark 12:15c-17
 - JESUS: Bring Me a denarius that I may see it. (Mark 12:15c)
 - JESUS: Who's image and description is this? (Mark 12:16)
 - PARISEES: Caesar's (Mark 12:16b)
 - JESUS: Render to Caesar the things that are Caesars and to God the things that are God's (Mark 12:17a)
 - PHARISEES: And they all marveled at Him. (Mark 12:17)
