Introduction:

- 1. Wash One Another's Feet. John 13:14
- 2. Love One Another. John 13:34,35, 15:12,17; Romans 13:8; I Thessalonians 3:12, 4:9; I Peter 1:22; I John 3:11, 3:23, 4:7, 11, 12; II John 5
- 3. Be kindly affectionate to One Another with brotherly love, Romans 12:10a
- 4. In honor giving preference to One Another. Romans 12:10b
- 5. Be of the same mind to One Another. Romans 12:16
- 6. Therefore let us not judge One Another anymore, but rather resolve this, not to put a stumbling block or a cause to fall in our brother's way. Romans 14:13
- 7. Therefore let us pursue the things which make for peace and the things by which one may edify One Another. Romans 14:19
- 8. Now may the God of patience and comfort grant you to be like-minded toward One Another, according to Christ Jesus, Romans 15:5; Philippians 2:1-16
- 9. Therefore, receive One Another, just as Christ also received us, to the glory of God. Romans 15:7
- 10. Admonish One Another. Romans 15:14
- 11. Greet One Another. Romans 16:16; I Corinthians 16:20; II Corinthians 13:12; I Peter 5:14
- 12. Wait for One Another. I Corinthians 11:33
- 13. That there should be no schism in the body, but that the members should have the same care for One Another. I Corinthians 12:25
- 14. Through love serve One Another. Galatians 5:13-15, 26
- 15. Bear One Another's burdens. Galatians 6:2 With all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with One Another in love, endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. Ephesians 4:2,3
- 16. Therefore, putting away lying, each one speak truth with his neighbor, for we are members of One Another. Ephesians 4:25

- 17. And be kind to One Another, tender-hearted, forgiving One Another, just as God in Christ also forgave you. Ephesians 4:32; Colossians 3:12,13
- 18. Submitting to One Another in the fear of God. Ephesians 5:21 Yes, all of you be submissive to One Another. I Peter 5:5
- 19. Do not lie to One Another. Colossians 3:9
- 20. Admonishing One Another. Colossians 3:16
- 21. Comfort One Another and Edify One Another. I Thessalonians 4:18, 5:11
- 22. Exhort One Another. Hebrews 3:13 Let us consider (watch out for) One Another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling f ourselves together as is the manner of some, but exhorting One Another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching. Hebrews 10:24,25
- 23. Do not speak evil of One Another. James 4:11
- 24. Do not grumble against One Another. James 5:9
- 25. Confess your trespasses to One Another, James 5:16a
- 26. Pray for One Another, that you may be healed. James 5:16b
- 27. Finally, all of you be of one mind, having compassion for One Another. I Peter 3:8
- 28. Be hospitable to One Another, without grumbling. I Peter 4:9
- 29. As each one has received a gift, minister it to One Another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. I Peter 4:10
- 30. We have fellowship with One Another. I John 1:7
