3. Mature believers are to become stepping stones. (14:19-23)

C. We Must Graciously Please One Another. (15:1-20)

1. We are exhorted as mature believers to build up weaker believers: FAITH. (15:1,2)
2. We are encouraged as mature believers to look to the example of Jesus Christ: HOPE. (15:3-13)
3. We are enlisted as mature believers to minister the true gospel of Jesus Christ: LOVE. (15:14-20)
