Introduction: Romans 1:1-17

I. The Doctrine of Condemnation: (1:18-3:20)
A. The Rational Sinner. (1:18-32)

1. The Declaration of God's Righteous Anger and Wrath: "God is ALIVE and ANGRY!" (Romans 1:18a)

What a Holy God Has Done:

A. He has revealed His righteous anger and wrath. (v.18,19; 2:5)

II. The Declaration of Man's Reason: "God Is Dead!" (Romans 1:18,19)

What Ungodly Man Has Done and is Doing.

- A. He tries to drown out the voice of God in his conscience. (v.18,19)
- B. He tries to ignore the voice of God in creation. (v. 19b)

III. The Declaration of God's Revealed Truth. "God is TRUTH!" (v.17-20)

What a Righteous God Has Done:

- A. He has revealed truth to man of His holiness and righteousness. (v.17)
- B. He has revealed truth to man by His creation and through mankind's conscience. (v.19,20)

IV. The Declaration of Man's Guilt. "Man is DEAD and worthy of Judgment!" (v.20-23)

What an Ungodly Man Does:

- A. He sees, understands and believes there is a God. (v.20,21a)
- B. He stands defiant, unaccountable and unrepentant without excuse before a holy God. (v.20b)
- C. He stands in open rebellion as a hater and enemy of God. (v.21,30)
- D. He is unthankful and ungrateful in his depraved heart towards God. (v.21b)
- E. He chooses to become an educated depraved fool. (v.21c,22)
- F. He is an idolater. (v.23; Exodus 20:1-5)
