- Fishing for Rainbow Trout:

1. "Reformed" Sinners (Jews) are Judged According to Truth. (Romans 2:1-5)

- The Line: "...You are inexcusable, O man..." (verse 1a)
- The Hook: "...for you who judge practice the same things..." (verse 1b)
- How to Come to Salvation through the Truth: (Matthew 5:3-16)
 - a. True Sorrow leads to brokenness.
 - b. True brokenness leads to repentance.
 - b. True repentance leads to faith.
 - c. True faith leads to works.

2. "Reformed" Sinners (Jews) are Judged By Their Works. (Romans 2:6-10)

- The Net: "...the righteous judgment of God, ... will render to each one according to his deeds..." (Romans 2:5b,6)
- How to Come to Salvation through the Work of God in Christ:
 - a. The Goodness of God.
 - b. The Providence of God.
 - c. The Call of God.
 - d. The Tolerance, Longsuffering and Patience of God.

3. "Reformed" Sinners (Jews) are Judged With Impartiality. (Romans 2:11-16)

- The Bait: "...For there is no partiality with God..." (verse 11)
- The Sinker: "...God will judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ, according to my gospel." (verse 16)
- How to Come to Salvation through the Gospel: (1 Corinthians 15:3,4; 2 Corinthians 5:17-20)
 - a. The Law Reveals Sin. > Jesus was and is Sinless.
 - b. The Law Judges Sin. > Jesus Became Sin.
 - c. The Law Condemns Sin. > Jesus Bore the Full Wrath of God for Our Sin.
