## **Family Bible Church**

Under the leadership and direction of our Elder Board, the staff at FBC is comprised of a handful of people who fill a multitude of positions. On any given day, each one wears a number of different hats. We meet weekly for prayer as well as discussion of the business end of church life.

Traci Severns serves the staff and congregation of FBC as receptionist/data clerk/ministry assistant. She is basically the first point of contact in the business office and is available to assist everyone with whatever it is they need to get their job done. She continues to grow as a woman of God who is faithful in following God's direction for her in the areas of ministry and service. From paper work to errand running, she provides invaluable assistance to the staff and ministry leaders at FBC as well as a supporting role with Building Blocks Preschool. Traci works alongside ministry leadership and provides administrative support to all other areas of ministry. She also helps oversee and coordinate use of resources and facilities.

Allison Ogborn is the Director of Building Blocks Preschool, A Ministry of Family Bible Church. She has prepared a report for BBP which continues to minister to over one hundred students and their families.

Pastor Peter Ernst is our Senior Pastor. Along with the men of God who serve in the capacity of Elders here at FBC, Peter shepherds the sheep of FBC. He greets, visits, counsels, disciples, preaches, teaches, ministers and prays daily. He has also prepared an additional report contained in this document.
