1. Two Honest Questions from a Holy God. (What God Expects) Psalm 15:1

- Who may abide in Your Tabernacle? Who may approach God?
- Who may dwell in Your holy hill? Who may abide with God?

2. Five Honest Answers from Holy Men, (Women). (What God Inspects) Psalm 15:2-6

1.) My Character Must be Holy. (V.2a,b) – My Character Matters to God.

- He pursues blamelessness.
- He practices righteousness.

2.) My Conversation Must be Holy. (V.2c-3a) – My Relationships Matter to God.

- He speaks truth.
- He suppresses slander.

3.) My Contacts Must be Holy. (V.3b-4b) – My Friendships Matter to God.

- He restrains himself from sin.
- He refrains from slurs.
- He rejects reprobates.
- He reveres believers.

4.) My Contracts Must be Holy. (V.4c-5b) – My Business Ethics Matter to God.

- He stands on the Word.
- He suffers for his word.

5.) My Commitment Must be Holy. (V.5c) – My Word Matters to God.

- He seeks intimacy with God.
- He proves loyalty to God.
