 3. They / we have been given Covenant Promises.
 4. They / we have been given the Law.
 5. They / we have experienced Temple Worship.
 6. They / we have lived the Promises of God.
 7. They / we have built on the foundation of the Patriarchs.
 8. They / we have been given the Human Ancestry of Jesus Christ.
